DAY ONE

This is a tribute to Sir Edmund Hillary, humanitarian, ambassador and one of the world's greatest explorers. The centre showcases the Aoraki Mount Cook region, its people and its place in the universe. We will enjoy some fantastic short films on the man himself, the park and a stunning planetarium display. After an informative day, we'll travel through the Hooker Valley onto the Heritage Gateway Hotel Omarama, where we will be enjoying our next night's accommodation. Relax and enjoy comfortable, country-style accommodation in the beautiful village of Omarama located close to lakes, mountains, and rivers, with dazzling starry skies by night. Tonight, we enjoy our meal at the on-site country style restaurant.

DAY FOUR
