DAY ONE

The scenic drive offers stunning views of Lake Pukaki and the braided Tasman River as we ascend into the mountains. At Mount Cook, we'll visit the Visitor Centre for an insightful talk about the National Park. Lunch follows at the Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre café in the Hermitage Hotel, celebrating the legendary explorer and showcasing the region with films and a planetarium display. After a day of discovery, we'll travel through the Hooker Valley to the Heritage Gateway Hotel in Omarama. Relax in country-style comfort, surrounded by beautiful landscapes and starry skies, and enjoy dinner.

DAY FOUR

Remember to bring a warm jacket and gloves as our day begins with a journey over the stunning Lindis Pass, with a stop for photos to capture the breath-taking views. DAY FIVE

Lunch will be at the acclaimed Riverstone Kitchen, followed by a guided tour of the dramatic Riverstone Castle, built from local Oamaru stone and surrounded by a picturesque lake on Dot and Neil Smith's dairy farm. Finally, we'll head to the seaside town of Timaru for our stay at the Comfort Hotel Benvenue. The evening concludes with dinner at the on-site restaurant, where we'll enjoy warm southern hospitality before retiring for a restful night.
